

First Give Programme Theory of Change

- Teacher support (including Programme calls, Teacher briefings etc.)
- First Give facilitated sessions (Assembly, Presentation Skills Workshop and Final)
- Teacher led sessions
- Students learn about social issues
- Students research and connect with local charities
- Students plan and carry out social action projects
- Students reflect on the impact of their social action projects
- Students create, plan and deliver presentations

INDICATORS OF REACH

- Young people feel inspired to give
 - Young people are inspired by their chosen charity
 - Young people have a sense of belonging to their community
- Young people feel confident in their abilities
 - Young people recognise the skills they've developed
- Young people feel like they have agency
 - Young people feel heard and respected
 - Young people feel ownership of the project
 - Young people feel a sense of achievement
- Young people enjoy the act of giving
 - Young people enjoy doing the First Give programme

MECHANISMS OF CHANGE

- Young people are better informed about the issues affecting their communities
 - Young people are more aware of social issues impacting their community
 - Young people are more aware of how charities tackle social issues in their community
- Young people understand the impact of giving
 - Young people understand the impact of their own social action
 - Young people understand the support that charities need
- Young people have the skills, attributes and confidence they need to give effectively
 - Young people develop key skills
 - Young people develop their empathy
 - Young people are more confident to make change in their community
- Young people are more likely to give to charities and causes that matter to them
